

A study on the relationships of scout activity participants' motivation, leisure involvement, and flow experience

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ABSTRACT

The aim of this study was to explore relationships among the scout activity participants' motivation and leisure involvement, and flow experience. The survey was using convenience sampling, resulted in 390 effective respondents. Independent t-test, one way ANOVA, Pearson's product moment correlation and stepwise multiple regression were adopted for data analysis. The results indicated that: 1. There were significant differences of demogrphics-education status, years of motive in the motivation . 2. There were significant differences of demogrphics in the leisure involvement. 3. There were significant differences of demogrphics in the flow experience. 4. There was significant positive correlation between the motivation and leisure involvement. 5. There was significant positive correlation between the motivation and flow experience. 6. There was significant positive correlation between the social psychological involvement and flow experience. 7. There were significant predicts in motivation and leisure involvement among the scout activity participants to flow experience. Finally, based on the findings and a comprehensive discussion some advices for related organization were offered.
